

Who may benefit from PACE services?

- Adults age 55 or older living in our PACE service area who need assistance in completing their daily tasks and getting the medical care they require.
- Caregivers assisting an older adult to remain safely in the community.

What does St. Vincent PACE cost?

Ascension Living St. Vincent PACE is funded by Medicare, Medicaid and private pay. As a Medicaid recipient, you may have little or no financial obligation.

Other than emergency services, all services must be approved by the Ascension Living St. Vincent PACE team. Cost for unauthorized or out-of-network services may be the responsibility of the participant.

Helping you remain safely at home

Ascension Living St. Vincent PACE (Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly) is a community-based program whose purpose is to help older adults with chronic conditions live in their own homes for as long as possible. Care is provided in the home, at the Ascension Living St. Vincent PACE center, and in the hospital or other necessary medical facility.

PACE is a unique system of personalized managed care based on an interdisciplinary team made up of:

- Doctors
- Nurses
- Medical social workers
- Home health aides
- Transportation providers
- Rehabilitation therapists
- Dietitians and others

How do I qualify?

- Be at least 55 years old
- Meet the level of care requirements according to State of Indiana guidelines
- Live in the defined PACE service area
- Be able to live safely in the community with support from PACE services

How do I join?

Call 463-271-3700 and ask to speak to someone in the Intake Department. They will explain the enrollment process. Enrollment is voluntary. You may disenroll at any time by notifying your Ascension Living St. Vincent PACE social worker.
